Search underway in Doniphan County for missing man

DONIPHAN COUNTY – The Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) has been asked to assist the Doniphan County Sheriff's Office in a search for a missing man.

On Monday, May 22, just before 9 a.m. the Doniphan County Sheriff's Office received information that led them to begin searching for a St. Joseph, Missouri man. The vehicle of the missing man was located shortly after. The KBI was asked to assist in the search at approximately 10 a.m. Monday.

The investigation progressed to a search of the Wolf River in Doniphan County. The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism is assisting KBI agents and Doniphan County Sheriff's deputies at the river.

This investigation is ongoing. Nothing further will be released at this time.
