KBI to unveil SAKI findings, launch public awareness campaign

TOPEKA-- Top law enforcement officials and victim advocacy groups on Thursday will announce findings and recommendations resulting from a five-year collaborative effort to identify, inventory, and test previously unsubmitted sexual assault kits in Kansas. Details about their efforts will be shared, and the Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) will announce the launch of a new statewide public awareness campaign surrounding sexual assault.
