Statewide Silver Alert issued for Burlington man

COFFEY COUNTY – The Coffey County Sheriff's Office requested that the Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) issue a statewide Silver Alert for a missing Burlington man.

The whereabouts of Dale Ernest Milburn, 78, are unknown, and the public's assistance is requested to help locate him. Milburn is 5 ft. 7 in. tall and weighs 150 lbs. He has brown eyes and gray hair.

Milburn was last seen wearing blue jeans and a white Relay for Life T-shirt. He was driving a white 2006 Chevy Silverado extended cab with tag 203GBU that was last seen around 4 p.m. turning south on Highway 75 from Burlington. Milburn has Alzheimer's disease, and is without medication.
